


NEWSLETTER COMPETITION WINNERS

P.E. KIT & CROSS COUNTRY RUNNING OUTFITS

I must apologise for any frustration or confusion caused over P.E. kit expectations this year...

Children are welcome to wear <u>any dark coloured tracksuit</u> over their burgundy P.E. kit in the colder weather. Once your child grows out of his or her current items, please aim to purchase <u>a black tracksuit</u> as this will be smarter for any matches in the winter months. However, this year, children should of course wear the kit you have purchased for them. (Some older pupils have black shorts instead of burgundy ones, ready for high school- this is fine, if your child has outgrown their burgundy ones. If you do not wish your child to wear the school burgundy P.E. shirt or a plain burgundy one, then a plain white t-shirt may be worn. (Obviously it is essential that the top worn for P.E. is a different one to the one worn in school.

With regard to cross country running club on Mondays, I have been advised that last year and before, the children could wear their own clothes for the lunchtime running club. This makes sense, especially if your child has school indoor P.E. in the afternoon, and may have got wet outdoors at lunchtime. Therefore, please feel free to send in a separate running kit if you wish, for your child to wear. Of course, there is NO compulsion to do this, and rather than rush out to buy anything extra if your child is new to the club, please wait to find out whether they will stick with it!

If your child is selected to compete in any cross country running competitions on behalf of the school, we will provide an Isleham gold running vest top which can be worn over their running kit or school PE kit.


