



SEPTEMBER PREPARATIONS

Please ensure your child is ready for the new school year by checking that school shoes and trainers fit prior to the retrun to school in September, and that any items bought for wear in school are clearly named with your child's name and adhere to our uniform regulations.

- PE kit consists of a **burgundy t-shirt with school logo or plain white** alternative, and **burgundy or black PLAIN shorts**, with **plain black or dark coloured tracksuit** for the winter months- please <u>NO</u> <u>sports branded/ sports logo-ed kit</u>. Please keep this for home or sports activities outside school.
