On Friday 29th September Year 6, Miss Hunt and Mrs Airey visited Mildenhall College Academy (MCA) for a Music Workshop. The MCA mini buses picked us up from Isleham and we enjoyed the short bus ride. On arrival we were welcomed by the MCA Principal, Ms Byles. Here, Ms Byles told us all about the school and the exciting plans that they have for the future. Ms Byles was very impressed by our children's ambitious career aspirations. There was a lot to see on our way to the music department and everyone was friendly and welcoming. Our workshop was led by Mrs Sayer, Mrs Wright and a super student named Tyler. We all had an African djembe drum each and we were taught different call and response rhythms. We were taught three different drumming techniques and were able to combine these with different rhythms. Also, we used improvisation and a few dance movements to represent each drumming technique. FORTHCOMING PARENT-TEACHER CONSULTATIONS

On the evenings of the 16th and 17th October, 4pm-7pm we will be holding our Parents' Evenings in the school hall. Please come along to chat to your child's teacher about your child's work so far this term and his/her targets for development.

10 minute appointments for Year 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6 parents and 15 minute appointments for Year R parents are bookable via the Starz online platform. Please log on with your username and password from the green login button on our main website page www.isleham.cambs.sch.uk after Wednesday 4th October at 12pm when booking opens, and select your preferred timeslot for your child's teacher. Your booked time is then automatically allocated to you. Booking closes on Thursday 12th October at 12pm.

Please note that it will not be possible to book to see staff on different evenings during the week of the 16th October before half term, as the staff will have been in school later than usual on two separate evenings already. Appointments must run to 10 minute time-slots (or 15 minutes for Year R parents) to avoid long delays for others.

Please note also that your child may attend the appointment, but needs to remain with you throughout the time they are in school and listen to the teacher's comments with you, rather than being left to roam the school or play with friends/ technology at the side of the hall.

Members of the school's Governing Body will be in attendance throughout the evenings, with a short questionnaire for you to complete. Please take the time to complete the form if you possibly can as response to the Governors' questionnaires help to guide the school's development priorities.
