Hello Parents and Carers at Isleham Primary School,

I just wanted to let you know how Mrs Bond and myself are doing, as we have received so many kind and supportive comments.

The operation went ahead as planned on Wednesday the 26th April and my kidney was transplanted into Mrs Bond. It's amazing that after a total of only 8 hours the procedure was completed! Thanks to all the expert staff and excellent care I received at Addenbrookes hospital, I was able to go home after only 2 days and continue my recovery in more relaxed and familiar surroundings. The staff at school gave me a wonderful box of gifts so I am spending my time reading, colouring, watching films, knitting and enjoying delicious snacks (although some of them may have been eaten before the procedure!)

Mrs Bond is still in hospital as I write this message, but should be allowed home just after the bank holiday weekend. Her new kidney started working straight away and is doing a great job, so let's hope it continues to get her back to full strength!

I will let you know again of developments over the coming weeks and thank you for all your thoughts and well wishes.

We also both wish the Year 6 children the best of luck with their SATS. All you can do is your best so keep trying and enjoy them!
