The heater has stopped working and the water would not be sufficiently warm for the children to swim in, now that the weather has turned colder. Obviously, this is disappointing for the children, especially those who were just starting to make gains with their swimming. We are very sorry about this, but have been advised by the engineers that the issue can not be resolved straightaway. We will therefore look to see if we can start swimming again at the end of the Spring Term 2017 to gain back some valuable swimming lesson time for the children once the issue has been resolved. Please be aware that the money raised towards the pool from the recent triathlon event will continue to support the running and maintenance of the pool next year.
