The children in Year 6 are shown below investigating how different bird's beaks have adapted so they can catch their food! With a range of different equipment eg tweezers, pliers, chop sticks, slotted spoons, they timed how long it would take to get the 'food' e.g. flying popcorn (insects), floating leaves (fish) and buried worms (sweets) They also investigated worm camouflage too- the children hunted for different coloured worms (string) outside.

In Year 1, the children made 'blow flying machines' as well as watching 'magic milk' react with paint. The class also thought about how their body changes during exercise. A very fun week was had by all!

In our assemblies this week, we are thinking about our school value of 'forgiveness'- pardoning wrongdoing.




