#### **CROSS COUNTRY SUCCESSES**

16 children represented Isleham on Wednesday last week in the Cambridgeshire School's Cross Country relay championship held in Priory Park St Neots. The children were superb ambassadors for the school; both the boys' and girls' A & B teams ran solidly and achieved well in the competition against much larger schools that ours.

The Isleham A team for boys was 34<sup>th</sup> out of the 137 school teams entered, and the Isleham A team for girls was 47<sup>th</sup> out of 108 school teams. All of the children can be very proud of their running and perseverance on the tough Priory Park course. Huge thanks go to Mrs Dalton-Cole who came with me to the competition and supports the children weekly at cross country club, and of course to Mrs Boneham for her excellent training of the team up until recently.
