Research shows that young people can become nervous and stressed when reading in school. However, when a PAT Dog is there, they often become less self-conscious and more confident as the dogs are non-judgemental. Before long the young people are starting to look forward to the reading experience as they are going to read to their new friend- the PAT Dog. PAT Dogs provide comfort, encourage positive social behaviours, enhance self-esteem, motivate speech and inspire young people to have fun with reading.

Basil has been visiting us since 2017, and we would like to raise some money this half term to support the Pets as Therapy Read2Dogs scheme and ensure Basil can continue to be registered to work with the children selected each week in our school.

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
