CHILDREN IN 'READ' DAY FOR 'CHILDREN IN NEED' & 'PETS AS THERAPY'


On Friday 19th November 2021, the School House Captains and School Council will be hosting a <u>Pyjama Day</u> for 'Children in Need Day'.

ATTENDANCE MATTERS



Just a reminder that whilst we remain incredibly grateful for vigilance in containing any possible cases of COVID-19 within our community and confirming via PCR if a member of the school community has COVID-19, children should please attend school at every possible opportunity unless a GP has or would deem them too poorly for school or unable to attend. Letters were sent last week to those families whose children's attendance rate this year sits below 92%- if this rate of attendance continued, across the course of a year, a child would have missed over 3 weeks of school learning. Please continue to consider the continuity of education for your child before keeping them at home for minor ailments. Thank you. Please note that it is still essential for any child with COVID-19 symptoms to have a PCR test and remain at home for 10 days if positive or until a negative result is received.
