The school will obviously seek to resolve any concerns you may have as quickly as possible by telephoning or messaging back. The Headteacher or Deputy Headteacher will be happy to look further into any concerns you may have if your concern has not been resolved by the class teacher initially. Our complaints policy is on the school website explaining the process. We are grateful to all of our parents for working with us and supporting the school staff to achieve the best they can for your children. If you should disagree with any decisions made, please address these concerns courteously to our staff, who, as in other workplaces, have the right to work without fear of aggression or abuse.

ATTENDANCE

Please note that if your child will not be in school for any reason, it is essential that you leave an email or phone message explaining why by 8.30am daily. In the situation that your child has not turned up at school, and we have not received any notification from you, we are duty-bound to call to check whether your child is ok and whether you were expecting for your child to have arrived at school. I hope you will understand that we need to check so that there is not a situation where you thought your child had walked into school, and they were not actually here throughout the day. In an extreme situation where your child has not arrived in school and there has been no notification to school, and no emergency contacts can be contacted to confirm the whereabouts of your child, we will call the Police, as we are duty-bound to check if there is a serious issue which has stopped your child from being in school. These measures are to protect your children.
