HELP! YOUR SCHOOL POOL NEEDS YOU...

We have the most fantastic swimming facility here at Isleham Primary School and we want to make the most of it for our children, but we need your help...



Only one parent came to the scheduled meeting last week to discuss the future of the Isleham Swimming Pool Association (the ISPA), and to help to form a new committee to see the pool open for children at least one evening/ after school session per week, and at weekends/ in the holidays according to demand.

If enough parents came forward to support the ISPA, then each parent volunteer would only be needed on an occasional basis to unlock the pool, carry out the necessary safety checks and be there for that session with their child(ren) and any families who wish to attend before locking up. All training would be offered.

However, with current interest levels, it seems it is not viable to offer any opening outside of school hours, and the ISPA will be forced to disband. Long term, this may also impact on the use of the school pool for swimming lessons, as we rely on the ISPA to bolster funds and support the school in meeting the expense of running and maintaining the school pool, and of course enabling children who would benefit from more regular swimming to practice in a familiar setting.

Mrs Cole has written the following message to summarise the situation...

Due to the very disappointing turnout at last Monday's I.S.P.A. meeting (just one parent) to gauge interest for new and existing members to form a new committee, it is with great regret that the ISPA will be forced to close. This will result in **NO** after school swimming sessions or weekend sessions and **NO** swimming sessions during the summer holidays.

The out-going ISPA's last fundraising activities will include Bags 2 School in the summer term and a possible non-uniform and cake break day, as these have already been planned. This will help to raise valuable funds to assist with the running costs of the school pool, ensuring all children can enjoy **FREE** swimming lessons during school time. Please remember too that the Co-op are raising funds with their help in the community contributions. This money will be used in the future to support the running costs of the pool.

If you feel disappointed by this decision and you are still willing to join the ISPA and are interested in forming a small committee, please complete the form above and hand to the school office by Friday 5th April. It would be such a shame to see this asset not being used for the good of the children and allowing them to access the pool outside of school hours.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank my fellow committee members for their support over the past few years but after nine years of commitment, my arm bands have deflated!

We hope to start swimming sessions from Monday 29th April, so please look out for the curriculum newsletters from your child's class teacher to let your know which day of the week your child will be swimming; as usual we are very grateful to you for your offers of help with the swimming sessions, so please sign up by your child's collection door if you can help with any sessions at the start of next term. Please also ensure your child has a suitable one piece costume for swimming, hat if their hair is not



cropped to their head, and towel for swimming. <u>Also, that ALL items, inlcuding underwear are clearly</u> <u>named with your child's name to avoid them being lost.</u> Boys please need short fitted shorts for swimming lesson, as long bermuda shorts can be very difficult to swim in.

Please can I also remind parents that children need smart grey or black trousers, shorts or skirts to wear for school, or a red/ burgundy summer dress - **Leggings, jeggings and jeans are not suitable for school**. Children also need PLAIN BLACK footwear- ideally school shoes or solid black trainers.

I hope that we can ensure all children are wearing the corect uniform by the start of the new term.
