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KUK SOOL WON CHAMPIONSHIPS- SUPERB SUCCESS FOR ISLEHAM PUPILS

Isleham pupils excelled in the recent Kuk Sool Won European Championships which took place at half term. DBN Max (Year 6) was promoted to his black belt meaning he is now a JKN and took part in the demo team on Saturday evening. He competed in 4 categories winning a Gold for staff and then copper (fourth place) for form, technique and sparring.
