- DECIMAL DRAPE:** Multiple versions of a game where a snake-like path is drawn on a board, with numbers placed along the path. Instructions often involve rolling a die and moving a token.

- Instructions:** Handwritten cards providing rules for the games, such as "Roll the die, move the token, land on a number, if it's a 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, you get to move your token." or "Roll the die, move the token, land on a number, if it's a 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, you get to move your token."
- Other Games:** A 'GAM' board with a path and a 'Instructions' card, and a 'DECIMAL DRAPE' game board with a snake-like path and a 'Instructions' card.

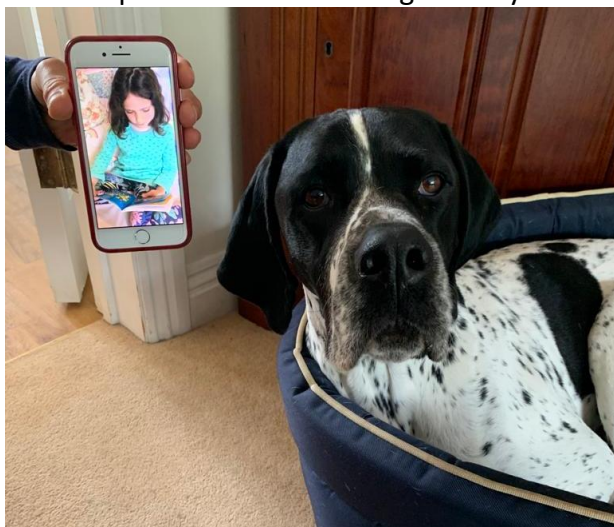

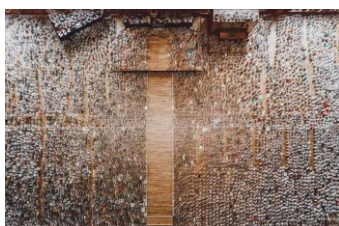
BASIL THE DOG
