# SATELLITE CRASHES

A satellite crashed at Isleham C of E Primary school on Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> of March 2019 in the school field. There were various sightings around the village but none of them that close.

The scene included an old, upturned grey table in the middle of the bark chips. It had a huge scrape mark on top of the ground. Also opposite the table there was a small dome - it is thought to be the remains of the satellite - Near the UFO there was a debris of shiny, silver aluminium foil draped over the branches of the silver birch tree. 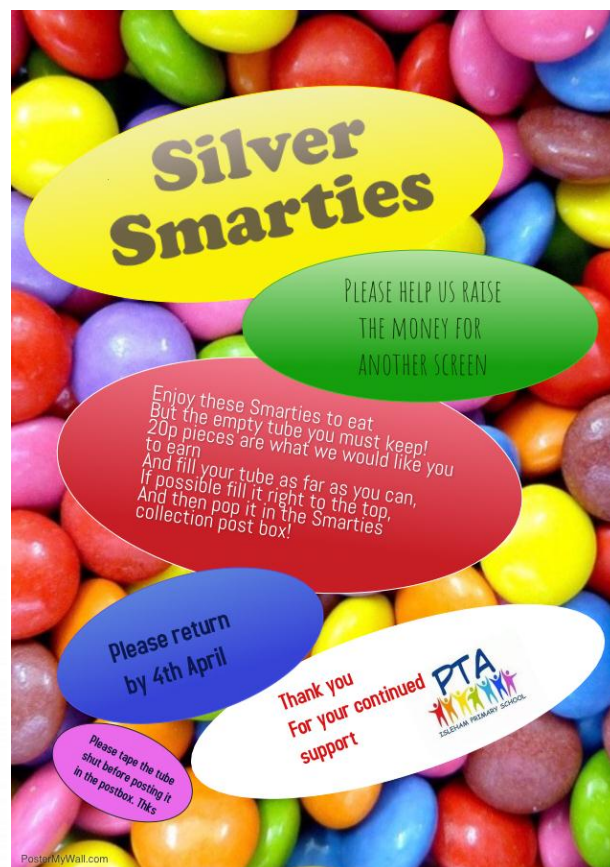
