The PTA are asking for DBS- checked parent volunteers to help supervise the children at the discos and tidy up after each event. If you would like to help, please email islehampta@gmail.com. We will need up to 3 helpers from each year group.

For the Reception and Key Stage 1 event, please consider carefully whether your child will wish to take part in the disco. Children will be in the hall and need to get involved in the games and dances whether or not you are in attendance- if they do not like busy spaces, or loud noises, it may be best to avoid this event. It is not compulsory to attend, and it does not make sense for us to be trying to provide a quiet creche for those who don't like discos.

ENTRY FEE FOR DISCO- SUPPORT FOR ALL TO ATTEND IF NEEDED The cost of attending is a suggested entry fee of £2.50. However, the PTA are keen for all children to attend if they wish to. In order to ease any financial strain, parents are welcome to make any affordable donation via envelope prior to the event and then no money is needed on the evening. If parents wish to pay the full £2.50 per child, this can also be paid in advance by envelope if preferred which will enable the children to enter the disco without queuing to hand over money. Please just remember to add your child(/ren)'s name to the envelope.


