THE ISLEHAM SCHOOL P.T.A. (PARENT TEACHER ASSOCIATION) NEEDS YOU





Last Friday- the 6th October 2017- at 3.30pm, the Annual General Meeting of the Isleham Primary School P.T.A. took place. The committee group are celebrating another amazing year of fundraising in 2016-17 for the children at Isleham Primary.

As in previous years, <u>over £3500</u> was raised enabling the PTA to subsidise £700 towards school trips, £350 towards Year 6 leavers' gifts & £2000 towards resurfacing the new reflection area used by all of the children at playtimes and in the summer months. The PTA helped raise these funds through exciting events for the children such as the Christmas Fair, school discos, Mothers/Father's day stalls, sports day house colour kits & summer concert refreshments.

Without the hard work of the committee and volunteers, none of the above could happen- parents would need to pay more for school visits in order for any trips to be able to go ahead... extra projects outside school budget would not be able to take place, and there would be no extra budget for treats like ice lollies on sports day, leavers' gifts or discos without charging parents a huge amount to subsidise these extras.

Sadly, in recent years, there have been fewer and fewer parents contributing to the PTA, which means that our PTA has come to a crisis point. The same few people cannot always plan, set up, deliver and clear away after all events for the children and families without exhaustion setting in.

The PTA needs more members to contribute to the group's success and join the committee this year, in order to help with organising and supervising/ running fun events for the year ahead for the children and parents. By agreeing to do this, you will also be able to help shape the development of the group and projects, and help to decide upon the extra things which you would like to fund to make our children's experience of school special.


